

Cheer Evolution will award at least 6 bids to the Cheerleading Worlds from the following divisions:

Senior 5 (Small, Medium etc). International Open 5 International Open Coed 5 International Open 6 International Open Coed 6

Partial Paid bids will be awarded the highest scoring teams from these divisions; Level 6 teams will be limited to no more than 50% of the partial paid bids. Only one partial paid bid per program is permitted within each Canadian Cheer event.

Teams who have been awarded an At-Large bid are eligible for a Partial Paid. The event producer who awarded the At-Large bid will be notified by Cheer Evolution staff.

Partial Paid Bids are worth \$3000 USD paid directly to the USASF upon registration for the Cheerleading World Championship.

Teams not competing for a bid, but competing in the above listed divisions will still be scored on the Canadian Cheer Worlds Qualifier system and ranked within their division.

Run 1 is worth 30% of the total final score, Run 2 is worth 70% of the final score.

Worlds deductions will be utilized. Please visit usasfrules.com for more details regarding boundary violations, time limits, point deduction penalties. All teams will be judged on the Universal Scoresheet.

At-Large bids will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Judges recommendation regarding the ability of the team to have a positive and competitive experience at the World Championship
- Final scores and rankings
- Scoring across divisions (ie strong teams from Senior divisions may be chosen although their scores are comparably lower to weaker International teams)

Bids are not to be used as a recruitment tool. Any program found to be utilizing their bid to solicit athletes from other programs may have their bid revoked and be banned from future Canadian Cheer bid qualifying competitions.

Teams with ineligible athletes, any athlete not rostered or checked in with official Canadian Cheer staff prior to competing, will not be eligible for a bid.
